Code of Conduct Dispensation Request Part One

This form must be submitted to the Clerk by Councillors who would like to apply for a dispensation to participate at any meeting of the Council, its Committees, or Sub Committees, on any item in which they will declare an interest. This form must be presented to the Clerk before the meeting has commenced. A dispensation may be granted if the Council considers that:

- a) without the dispensation the number of persons prohibited from participating in any particular business would be so great a proportion of the body transacting the business as to impede the transaction of the business; or
- b) without the dispensation the representation of different political groups dealing with that business would be so upset as to alter the likely outcome of any vote; or
- c) granting the dispensation is in the interests of persons living in the Council's area; or
- d) without the dispensation each Member of the Council's executive would be prohibited from participating in the business; or
- e) it is otherwise appropriate to grant a dispensation

Good morning

I should like to request a dispensation allowing me speak and vote on the Star Inn planning application at the next council meeting.

I am part of a group of parishioners who have applied for an ACV listing for the Star Inn. We are also in discussions with the Plunkett Foundation. There has been an offer of £250 towards the cost of a survey on the Star Inn and I have offered to match that if necessary.

I believe that because a relatively large number of parish councillors are involved in this process the likely outcome of any decision on this issue would be scewed if I, and other councillors, were not able to speak and vote. It is also entirely possible that if those involved in the ACV listing were not able to speak and vote it would mean that we were non quorate at the meeting when it came to vote on this item.
