## Code of Conduct Dispensation Request Part One

This form must be submitted to the Clerk by Councillors who would like to apply for a dispensation to participate at any meeting of the Council, its Committees, or Sub Committees, on any item in which they will declare an interest. This form must be presented to the Clerk before the meeting has commenced. A dispensation may be granted if the Council considers that:

- X a) without the dispensation the number of persons prohibited from participating in any particular business would be so great a proportion of the body transacting the business as to impede the transaction of the business; or
- b) without the dispensation the representation of different political groups dealing with that business would be so upset as to alter the likely outcome of any vote; or
- c) granting the dispensation is in the interests of persons living in the Council's area; or
- d) without the dispensation each Member of the Council's executive would be prohibited from participating in the business; or
- e) it is otherwise appropriate to grant a dispensation


