Planning Application 23/02875/PLF

Proposal: Crown reduce 4 no Birch trees by approx. 1m all round and shape; Crown reduce 2 no Cypress trees by approx. 2m; crown reduce 1 no gold crest conifer tree by approx. 2m. All work to be carried out to allow more light into the garden and also as the deeds for the property state all trees must be kept below the height of 10ft.
